List of clinical and research interests in Plastic Surgery Units

At some time in his or her career a plastic surgeon takes time to visit plastic surgery departments at home or abroad. However, apart from certain well trodden trails to much publicised hospitals, it is not always easy to arrange the sort of itinerary to match the interests of the peripatetic trainees or trainers. There are plastic surgeons who work out of the limelight in smaller units who could well offer something of great surgical value to the visitor.

For this reason the Education and Research Subcommittee of the British Association of Plastic Surgeons has compiled a list of plastic surgery units in the United Kingdom and Eire, giving a brief description of the main clinical and research interests together with the times of weekly teaching ward rounds and seminars, of the main operating and out-patient sessions, and availability of accommodation.
